
7. Brief Report:

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

5. Objectives of the visit: To study about the ecosystem of sanipai forest.

To understand the importance of ecosystem.

To know the difference between forest and aqutic

ecosystem.

To imbibe the habit of investigation which is part of research. To cultivate the culture of team work among the students.

6. Observations:

The sanipai range (Balarajupalle) of forest abounds in red sanders (Pterocarpus santalinus) which is endangered plant, it also abounds in many types of herbal plants which are very useful and widely used in making herbal medicines. Significantly it is observed that it is a dry deciduous forest and belongs to Seshachala biosphere, in that 1600 species,1100 genus and 108 families are present. Apart from many herbal and medicinal plants. This forest is rich in timber yielding plants like Teak, Rose wood, arjun. Mainly ten species were dominated in this forest. We were also observing lotic ecosystem near to this forest.

All the students have participated with interest and willingness in the field trip. Lot of group discussion and exchange of views have taken place among the students. The students had ample opportunity to interact with their lecturer and learned many things about the forest ecosystem. All the students have opined that such kinds of field trips are not only useful in the forthcoming examinations but also created interest in them to pursue higher education including research.
