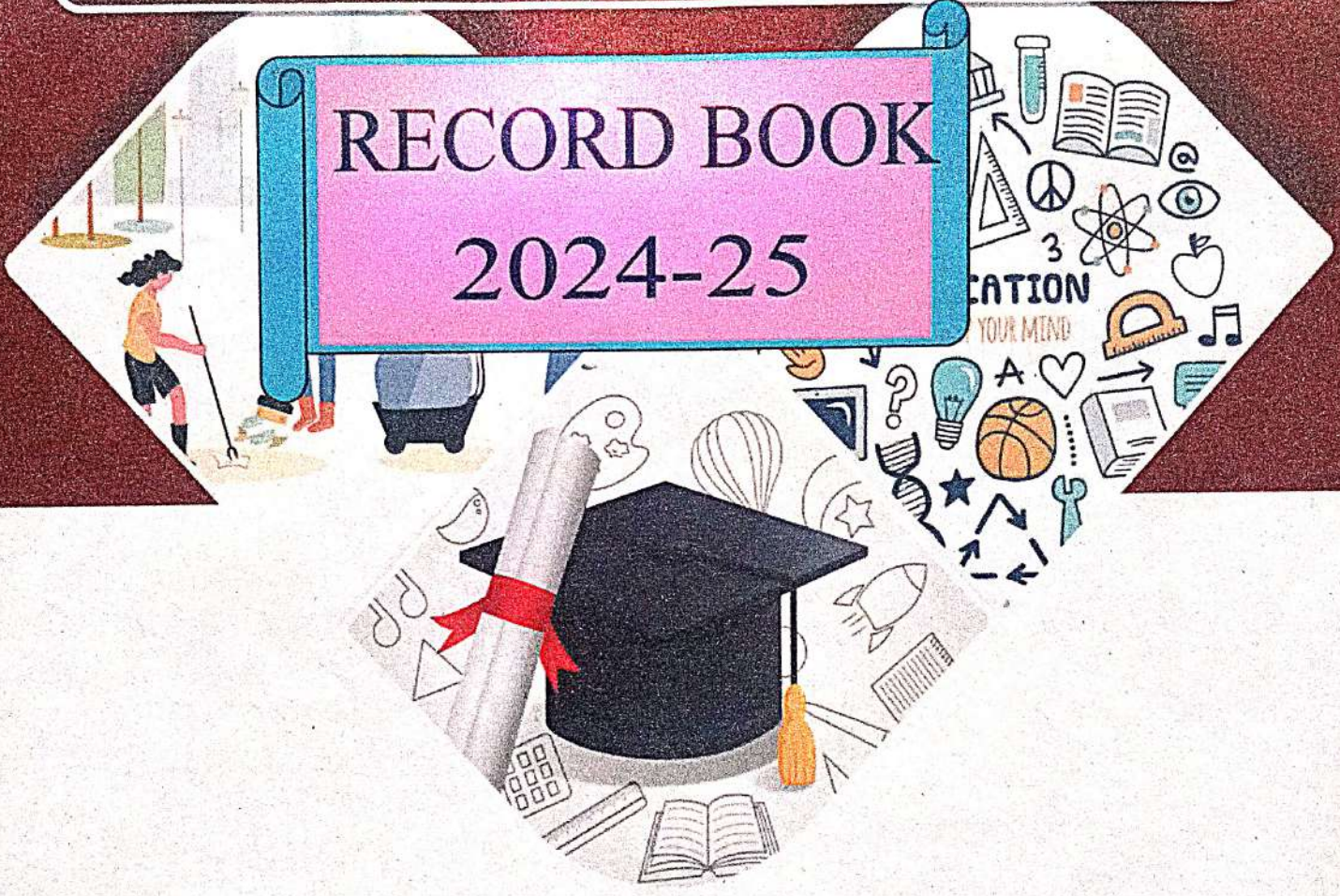

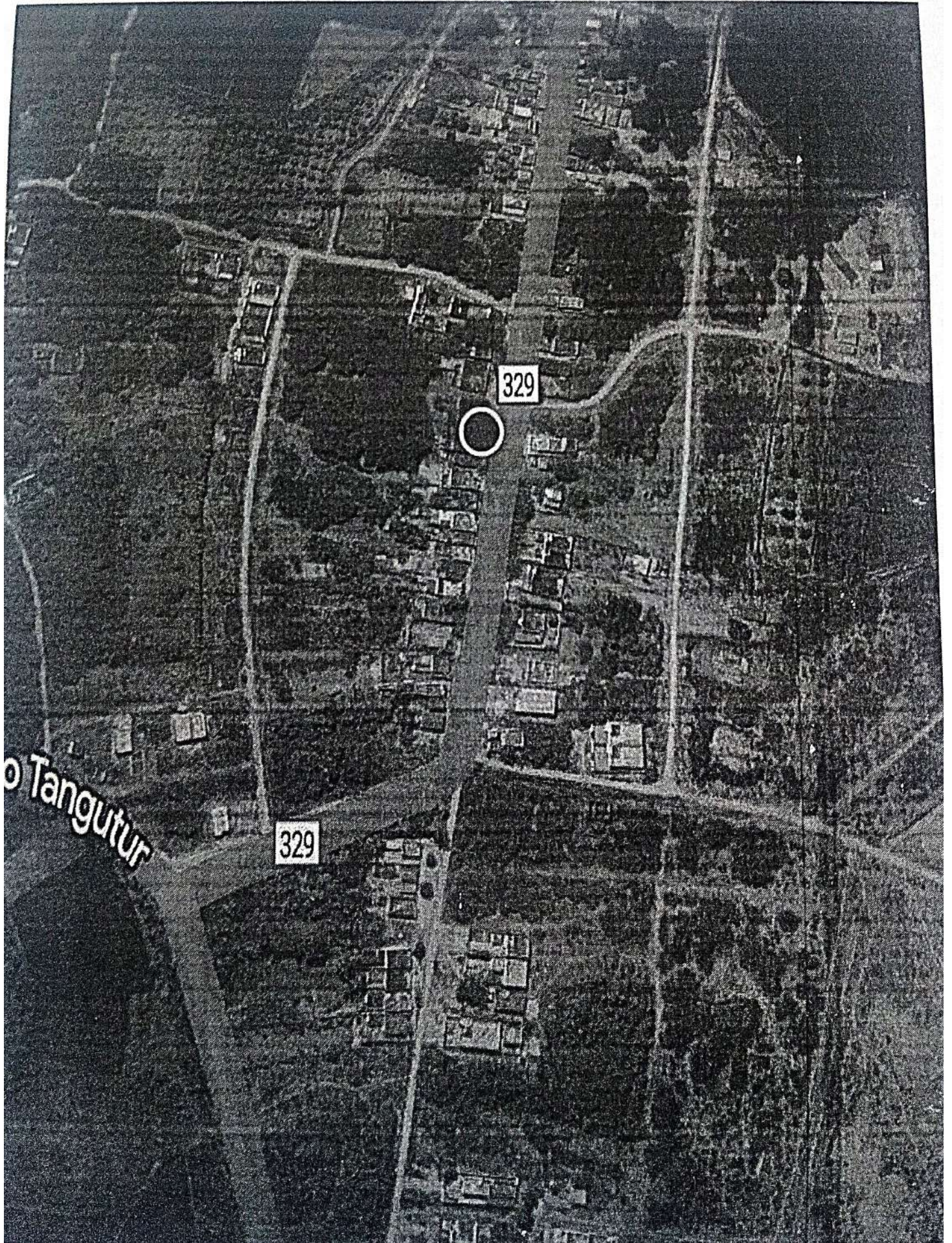
4.SWACHH ANDHRA

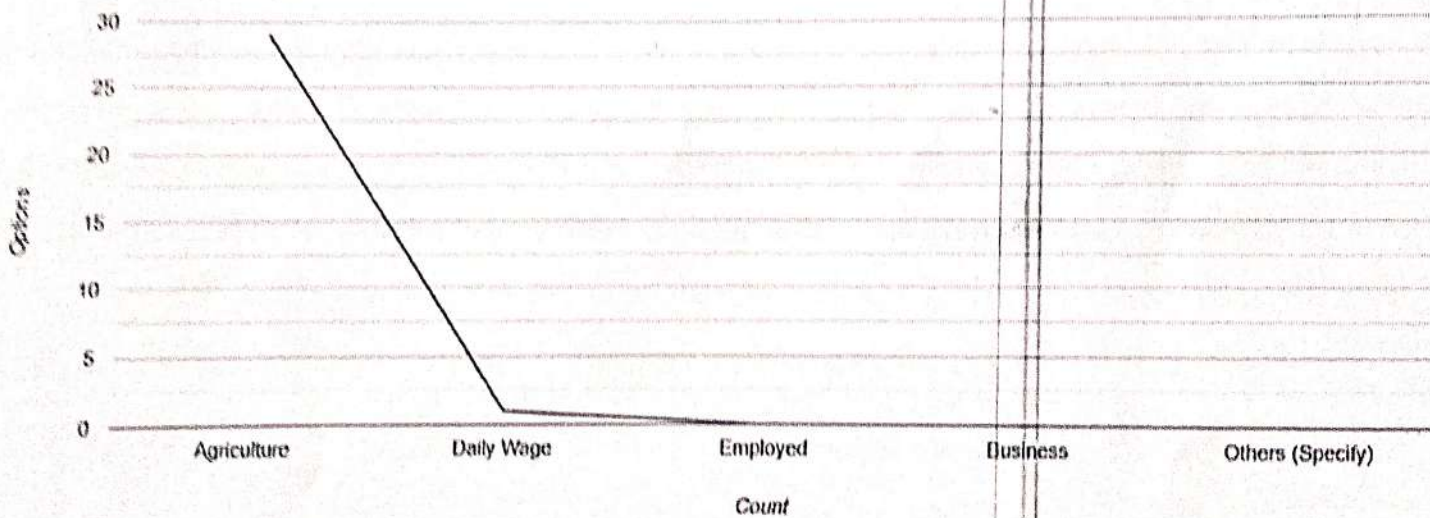




Primary Occupation of the Head of the Household




