8. Brief Report : World Ozone Day, also known as the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, is observed annually on September 16 to bring attention to the ozone layer and the dangers of ozone depletion. The purpose of the day is to raise awareness about the importance of preserving the ozone layer. In 1994, the UN General Assembly declared September 16 to be the annual International Day to Preserve the Ozone Layer. The governments of 46 countries across the globe signed the "Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer" in 1987, and this was done to celebrate this event. Significance The ozone layer present in the Stratosphere absorbs most of the sun's UV radiation and reduces the amount of radiation that reaches people. The ozone layer is crucial because radiation is a known cause of cancer, cataracts, and other health problems. Man-made chlorofluorocarbons are among the most major ozone layer killers. To provide awareness to the students Dept. of Botany, Zoology and NSS conducted "World Ozone Day" on 16-09-2023. The theme for world ozone day 2023 is "Montreal protocol fixing the ozone layer and reducing climate change". For this programme we invited Sri Subramaniyan Venkataraman, Rtd.
