7. <u>Brief Report :</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ To provide knowledge on the freedom fighters and the role of Sri Pottisriramulu garu in the formation of Andhra Pradesh state, Depts. Of zoology and Telugu combinely organized Vardhanthi of Sri Pottisriramulu garu and Sri Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel Programme on 15-12-2025.➤ Potti Sriramulu (1901-1952) was an Indian freedom fighter and Gandhian activist revered as "Amarajeevi" (Immortal Being) for his ultimate sacrifice.➤ Key Contributions & Life➤ Freedom Fighter: Joined Gandhi's ashram, participated in the Salt Satyagraha (1930) and Quit India Movement (1942), and was imprisoned multiple times.➤ Social Activist: Fought for Dalit rights, including temple entry in Nellore, and undertook fasts for social justice.➤ Champion for Andhra State: Demanded a separate state for Telugu speakers from the Madras Presidency, believing in governance in one's own language.➤ "Amarajeevi": His sacrifice on December 15, 1952, after 58 days of fasting, led to widespread unrest and the announcement of Andhra State by PM Nehru just days later.➤ Legacy: His death was a catalyst for the State Reorganisation Commission and the creation of linguistic states across India. <p><u>Impact</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ His fast demonstrated immense willpower, with Gandhi noting he'd need more followers like Sriramulu to win freedom quickly.➤ His sacrifice is commemorated with statues and institutions, recognizing him as the Founding Father of Andhra Pradesh, according to Indian National Congress.

➤ **Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel**, India's first Deputy PM and Home Minister, was a key freedom fighter known as the "Iron Man of India" for his strong leadership in uniting over 500 princely states into one nation after independence. He was a brilliant lawyer who led successful non-violent campaigns (Satyagrahas) against the British, earning the title 'Sardar' (Chief) and dedicating his life to India's unity and strength.

Key Roles & Contributions:

Freedom Fighter: A close follower of Mahatma Gandhi, he led peasant movements like the Kheda and Bardoli Satyagrahas.

Iron Man: Nicknamed for his resolve in integrating princely states into the Indian Union, ensuring India's territorial integrity.

First Deputy PM & Home Minister: He managed crucial internal affairs, including refugee relief and maintaining peace after Partition.

Architect of Unity: His unwavering commitment to a united India made him a Father of the Modern Indian Nation.

Out put: From this programme students know the sacrifices the life of freedom fighters. They got the ability to express the views regarding freedom fighters with out fear.
