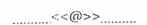

- 13. Never be hesitant to ask questions to make sure you fully understand what you need to do your work and to contribute to the organization.

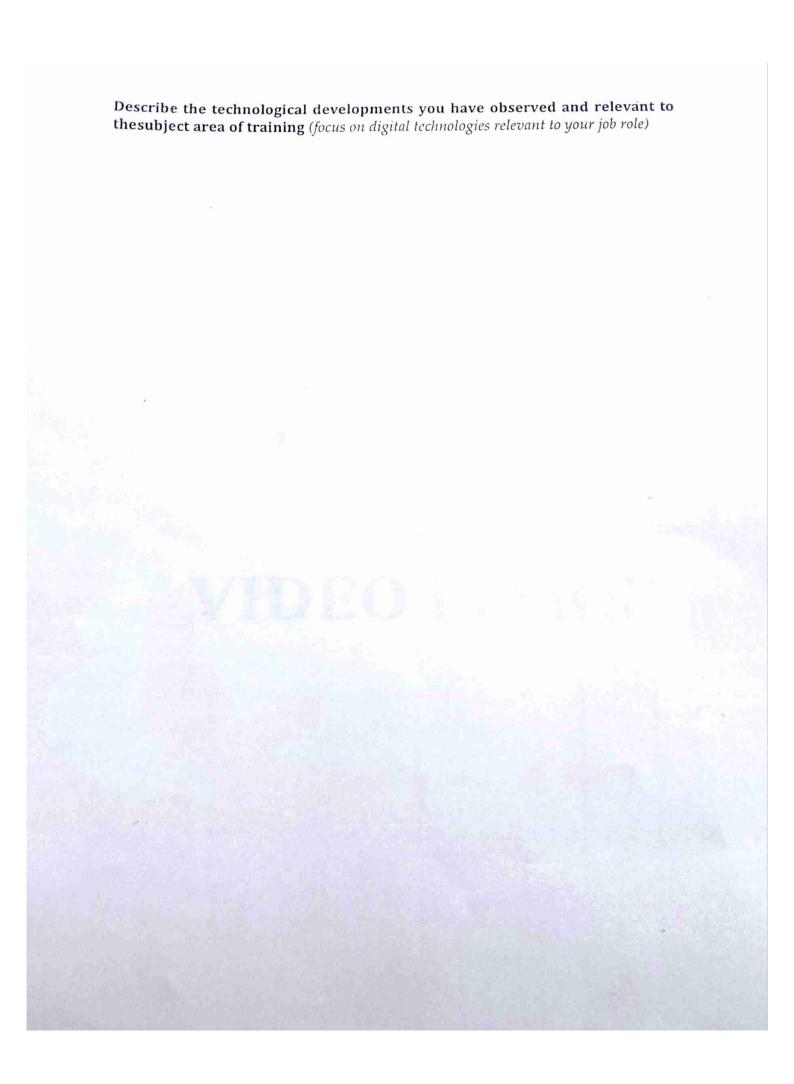

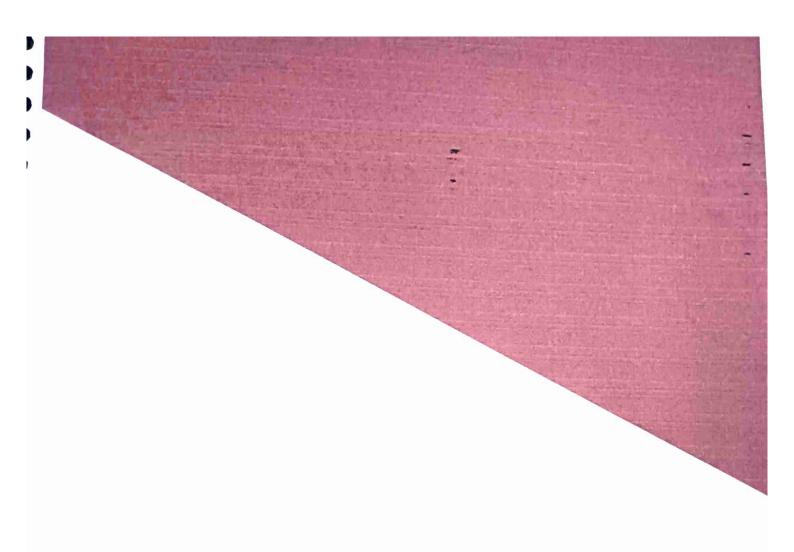
