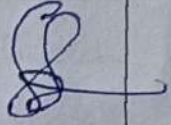
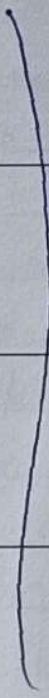

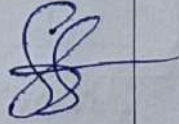
About Excel Introduction

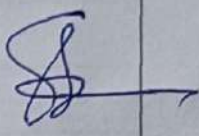

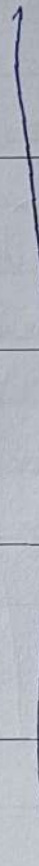

When you want to freeze a cell reference or you do not want a reference to change when you copy and formula, you can use absolute cell reference to make a cell reference. To make absolute cell reference, To make a dollar (\$) sign before the column name and row number of the references.

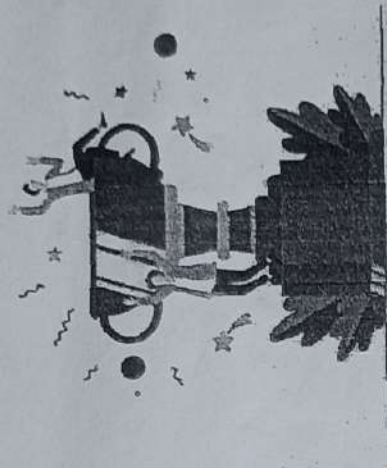

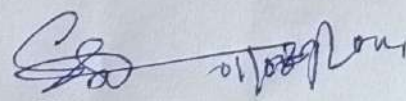

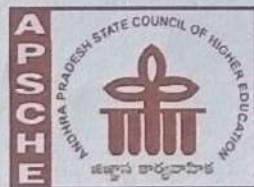
